

## PSO Meeting April 14, 2008

Sherry welcomed everyone to the meeting.  
The minutes from March 2008 were read and approved.

### Treasurer's Report

Michael Shaw reported that we are on plan so far this year. This years spring fundraiser brought in almost \$28,000. The paddle raise funds have been spent on the document projectors. The dare t-shirts cost ½ of last years. Mainly because Tigard Police pays for half. We've earned \$1100 from specialty fundraisers and \$500 for box tops.

### New Business

Sherry reported that we now have a new trophy case in the lobby. We have seven new document cameras and the dvd players should be arriving this week.  
The May PSO meeting has been moved from Monday 5/12 to Wednesday 5/14 to coincide with the volunteer appreciation program. We will also be voting on the new PSO board at that meeting.

### Committee Reports

#### Field Day

Sherry let us know that Kindergarten field day will be on June 6 and grades 1-5 will be on June 10. Grades 1 and 2 in the afternoon and 3-5 in the morning. Keep an eye out for information on volunteering.

#### Carnival

Michelle Woodworth reported that this years carnival is a circus theme "Under the Big Top". It will take place on 5/30 from 4:30-8:30. We need volunteers to coordinate decorations.

#### Staff Appreciation

Sherry reminded us that staff appreciation week is May 5-9. There will be information in the Friday Flyer. One new idea this year is kids can design their own t-shirt recognizing their teachers.

#### Family Events

Sherry reported that 4/18 will be the mother/son date night with Pasta Veloce serving spaghetti. There will be a lot of prizes. We need volunteers to check people in. The cost is \$15 per couple, each additional child \$5.  
4/25 will be the third annual father/daughter dance. The cost will be \$15 per couple. There will be a live DJ and dessert. There will be pictures taken too.

#### Art Lit

Sherry let us know that the art lit gallery will be set up next week for Education Week. The kids are currently studying DiVinci and getting sketch books.

#### Box Tops

Sherry reported for Lisa Lewis that she recently sent in \$590 worth of box tops. We have 10,012 points for Campbell's soup labels. The current contest runs though May.

### Funds Task Force

Michael reported that the Funds Task Force is finished meeting this year. Thanks to the team who helped. They spent time interviewing teachers and Mrs. Foiles. They received 36 responses to the parent survey. The committee met about five times. Their goals were to allocate funds quickly, maintain a healthy budget, include parent and teacher wishes and have an open process. Approvals included Instructional Assistants (reading and math), Innovative Grants through TTSD, supplemental educational materials, technology purchase (either 1 Senteo system, 1-2 document camera systems or a clicker system where students buzz in answers-leaving this up to the school to decide), and a sound system for the cafeteria. A question was raised about the field trips funding. There is already \$10 per child plus a bus fund. They sat down with the fifth grade teachers to make sure they know how much money is actually being allocated.  
Motion was approved to accept the Proceeds Committee proposal.

### Exec Board Search Committee

Pam Engle stated we have a treasurer for next year. Still working on recruiting for the other positions.
