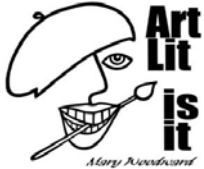

Salmon, Ravens and Bears, Oh My!

According to ancient stories passed down by word of mouth, the NW Coast Indians believed their ancestors had once been animals who shed their

“clothing” of fins, feathers or fur to become men and women. For this reason, the Indians felt a close relationship to all living things; and to show their respect, they made animal crests (visual symbols of fish, birds and animals). Each crest was considered the property of the clan that created it.

The Indians decorated everything with these animal crests—their masks, totem poles, tools, houses, clothing, canoes, and household objects. Each time someone used an animal crest, they were giving thanks to their animal ancestor. Incorporating this art into daily life was a way to keep the people closely connected to their sources of food and comfort, as well as their cultural and spiritual roots. This month in Art Lit, the kids will be using traditional animal crest designs in creating a miniature version of a NW Coast Indian “button blanket.”

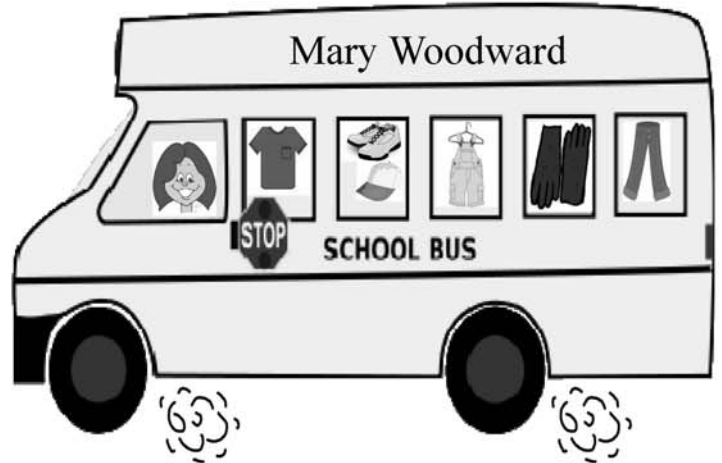
