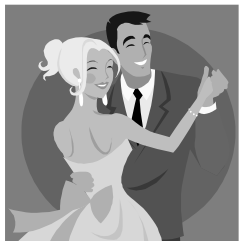

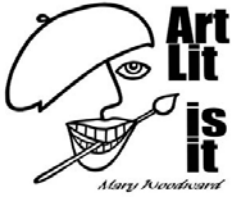

## WILD ABOUT WARHOL



Printmaker, painter, illustrator, avant-garde filmmaker. Andy Warhol made his way from a working-class Pittsburgh

upbringing to become a Pop Art legend. Born in 1928, he originally trained as a commercial artist. Later, he developed the technique of projecting photographic images to a silk screen, which enabled him to produce repetitive patterns within the same piece relatively quickly.

Warhol's work always alternated between glorification and criticism of American mass culture, as he created iconic images of famous people and ordinary objects like soup cans and dollar bills. Warhol is credited as the leading force behind the American Pop Art movement. He is also remembered for saying – prophetically, it now seems – “In the future, everyone will be world-famous for 15 minutes.” This month in Art Lit, the kids will be creating colorful, poster-like drawings with the stylized look of Warhol.
