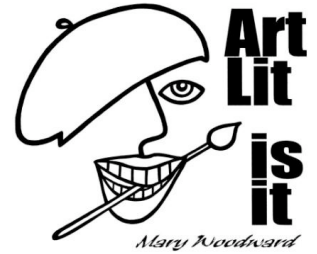


Welcome to Art Lit!

Thank you for volunteering in your child's classroom. We're very excited to share this year's artists and projects. It's going to be a fun year for you and the kids!



We'll be featuring six different artists this year—in October, November, January, February, March and April. In most months, we'll meet on the first Wednesday to learn about the artist and project (choose from an 11:45am or 6:45pm training time.) Due to the holidays, we don't meet in December. In May, we hold the school-wide Art Gallery and host an event to thank you for your support.

With so many Art Lit volunteers to contact, we'll be communicating with you primarily through email. Please let us know ASAP if there's a better way to reach you, or if your email address changes during the school year.

BIG NEWS! We now have a portable classroom dedicated to Art Lit! All classroom and most volunteer training sessions will be held in this room. You also now have a choice of coming to a daytime or evening training session.

FIRST ART LIT MEETINGS:

Wednesday, Oct. 5th 6:45-9pm OR Thursday, Oct. 6th 11:45am-1:45pm

The evening session will be held at Cami Bunnell's home
(13025 SW Broadmoor Place - nearest cross-street: 135th & Whitehall)

The daytime session will be held in the portable at school
(Located to the far right of the main entrance to the school - Look for the sign and balloons.)

We'll review the Art Lit program and yearly schedule, sign up for class presentation times, introduce the October artist and project, and answer your questions about Art Lit.

All volunteers should attend 1 session!

At the October meeting, you'll sign up for your classroom's Art Lit time slot for the year.

So, what should you do before the October meeting?

- Touch base with the other Art Lit volunteers in your class to see whether the Wednesday or Thursday meeting works best for most of you. We recommend that team members attend the same session, so you can meet one another in person.
- Designate your Team Leader, and notify us of your decision.
- The Team Leader will be the liaison between the team and the teacher. The Team Leader should contact the teacher and ask what day and time works best for Art Lit (i.e. the third Wednesday of the month, from 11-12:30). It's best to have several choices, in case your first choice isn't available on the Master Art Lit Calendar. Plan to schedule a minimum of an hour for each artist. Many teachers may be able to give you a little more time. And please keep in mind that extra time will be needed to transport the kids to and from the portable.
