


Grant Wood Project Steps

Project Overview: *Students will create rural landscapes in the style of Grant Wood*

Project Materials: White paper No. 2 pencil colored pencils black paper for mounting



Volunteer Preparation

- ✓ Each child will receive a white paper, a No. 2 pencil and a set of colored pencils
- ✓ Teachers are welcome to participate in the lesson - let them know! ☺

Step 1: Draw your landscape	Step 2: Add color, texture, and design!	Step 2: Cleanup	Step 3: Mounting
<i>Pass out white paper, pencil</i>	<i>Pass out colored pencils</i>		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Write your name and class code on the back of your paper with your pencil. 2. Flip your paper over and make it horizontal. 3. First draw your horizon as a long curvy line from one side to the other of the top 1/4th of your paper 4. Next (in the bottom 3/4s of your paper) add fields and hills, then roads/rivers/ponds, and finally trees and buildings - use simple shapes and designs to fill in your fields with “crops” 5. Remember that realism isn’t what you want - use simple shapes and designs 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Once you have a scene drawn on your paper, it’s time to color! 2. Explore the different effects you can get with your colored pencils by pressing harder or softer 3. Color large empty spaces (like the sky) by first coloring one way, then going over it the other way 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Collect completed drawings, pencils, and colored pencils ➤ Clean up tables with wipes as needed – have the kids help. ➤ PLEASE organize cart so it’s neat and ready for the next class. ➤ Notify chairs right after your class if fresh supplies are needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ See example of mounting on the wall. ➤ Use glue stick to affix art onto black paper ➤ Affix student labels to the bottom center bottom of paper. ➤ Hang artwork in the teacher’s designated space using clear tacks in each corner. ➤ Place previous art in your blue storage bin in the Art Lit Storage room (off the first alcove to the right in the gym)
