

Toulouse-Lautrec Project Steps

Project Overview: *Students will create leaf prints in the style of Toulouse-Lautrec*

Project Materials:

- 8 ½ x 11” white and brown paper
- Pencils
- Black, red, yellow, orange printers ink
- Brayers for rolling
- Foam paint trays
- Foam squares for etching
- 9x13” Black paper for mounting
- Placemats

Volunteer Preparation

- ✓ Each child will receive a foam square and a pencil
- ✓ Volunteers must set up four printing stations - one for each color with matts, trays, paper, ink, and brayers at each station
- ✓ Teachers are welcome to participate in the lesson - let them know! 📧

<i>Pass out foam squares and pencils</i>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Etch a leaf design into the foam square 2. Press HARD - a dull pencil works best 3. Sketch some leaves before hand if you want to practice (provide examples) 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Set up four stations, one for each color with a matt, a tray, ink, and a brayer (roller) 2. Have the kids choose either white or brown paper and write their name and class code on the back 3. Help them load the brayer with a small amount of ink, then press the inked side down onto the front of their paper, and press firmly 4. Peel back the stamp (stamps may be discarded after use) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Move finished art to the drying racks. ➤ Wash all rollers and trays completely ➤ Clean up matts with wipes thoroughly ➤ PLEASE organize cart so it's neat and ready for the next class. ➤ Notify chairs right after your class if fresh supplies are needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ See example of mounting on the wall. ➤ Use glue stick to affix art onto black 9x13” paper ➤ Affix student labels to the bottom center bottom of paper. ➤ Hang artwork in the teacher's designated space using clear tacks in each corner.
