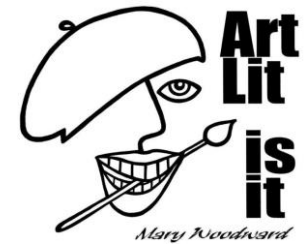


Aboriginal Project Steps

Project Overview: *Students will create boomerangs in the Traditional Aboriginal style.*

Project Materials:

- White Boomerang
 - Acrylic Paint bottles
 - Pencils w/ pin in top
 - Paper Towels
 - 9x13 Black paper for mounting
 - Hot Glue for mounting
- Kinders** use thick paint brush ends.



Volunteer Preparation

- ✓ Each child will receive a boomerang, a pencil and paint palette
- ✓ Place a placemat at each student spot to protect the desks.
- ✓ Teachers are welcome to participate in the lesson - let them know! 📧

Step 1: Choose your animal	Step 2: Outline in dots then add extras.	Step 2: Cleanup	Step 3: Mounting
<i>Pass out boomerang, pencil, and paint.</i>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Write your name and class code on the shiny side of your boomerang. 2. Flip your Boomerang over and trace your animal in the elbow. 3. If you want trace your extra design on the tips. 4. Wipe off pinhead between colors. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Start by outlining your animal. In the example they used brown. 2. Outline your extra design. 3. Add natural elements in dot form. In the video she added grass under the kangaroo. 4. Add in other aboriginal designs. 5. Be careful work from the inside out and turn your boomerang as needed to not smear the dots! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Move finished art to the drying racks. ➤ Collect supplies-wipe the pinheads with wet wipes ➤ Clean up tables with wipes as needed – have the kids help. ➤ PLEASE organize cart so it's neat and ready for the next class. ➤ Notify chairs right after your class if fresh supplies are needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>See example of mounting on the wall.</u> ➤ Use hot glue to affix to the 9 x 13 paper ➤ Affix student labels to the bottom center bottom of paper. ➤ Hang artwork in the teacher's designated space using clear tacks in <u>All four corners.</u>
