

Green Project Steps

Project Overview: *Students will create a painting in the style of Jonathan Green*

Project Materials:

- 6x9” White Paper
- Pencil
- Acrylic Paint (red, yellow, lt green, dk green, blue, brown, white)
- Paint brush
- Paint Tray
- Palette paper
- Cup with water for rinsing
- Paper towels
- Placemats
- Black 9x12” construction paper for mounting



Volunteer Preparation

- ✓ Each child will receive a sheet of white 6x9” paper, a pencil, paint tray with palette paper and 7 colors, a cup of water, and paper towels
- ✓ Place a placemat at each student spot to protect the desks.
- ✓ Teachers are welcome to participate in the lesson - let them know! 📧

<i>Pass out materials</i>			
1. Write your name and class code on the back of your paper 2. Flip your paper over and work in Landscape 3. Draw a line at the top one inch from the top Draw a second line half an inch below that Draw your figure (dress, torso, hat)	1. Paint the blue strip at the top 2. Fill in the dark green strip below that 3. Fill in the grassy area with light green, adding darker green and yellow as desired 4. Paint the figure, adding details like arms and embellishments to the dress and hat 5. Add finishing touches	➤ Move finished art to the drying racks. ➤ Collect supplies, wash brushes, throw away palette paper, wash trays if needed ➤ Clean up tables and placemats with wipes as needed – have the kids help. ➤ PLEASE organize cart so it's neat and ready for the next class. ➤ Notify chairs right after your class if fresh supplies are	➤ See example of mounting on the wall. ➤ Use glue stick to affix art onto black 9x12” paper ➤ Affix student labels to the bottom center bottom of paper. ➤ Hang artwork in the teacher's designated space using clear tacks in each corner.
